

Paměť míst, událostí a osobností: Historie jako identita a manipulace.

Until recently spent in the humanities and social sciences attention to the phenomenon of memory only to philosophers, psychologists and sociologists partly. Now it empowers historians, publicists and politicians. This suggests that by examining the individual human memory and forgetting in terms of human individuals, and indeed in terms of Freudian psychoanalysis focused moving on to analyze the collective memory, and especially its impact on the creation and preservation of collective memory and identity. The transformation of this approach also meant, that the phenomenon of "places of memory" ceased to be mere academic scholarly "fad" and became a highly political issue that can determine an explosive way for the past and even influencing the political behavior of the entire mental and social groups and even government institutions. Thinking about this methodological concept and its concrete elaboration brings this monograph thirty-five Czech, Slovak and French historians.
